
- Harold Washington was the only Chicago Mayor to speak at a regular monthly meeting September 9, 1987

Dear Fellow Business Owner,

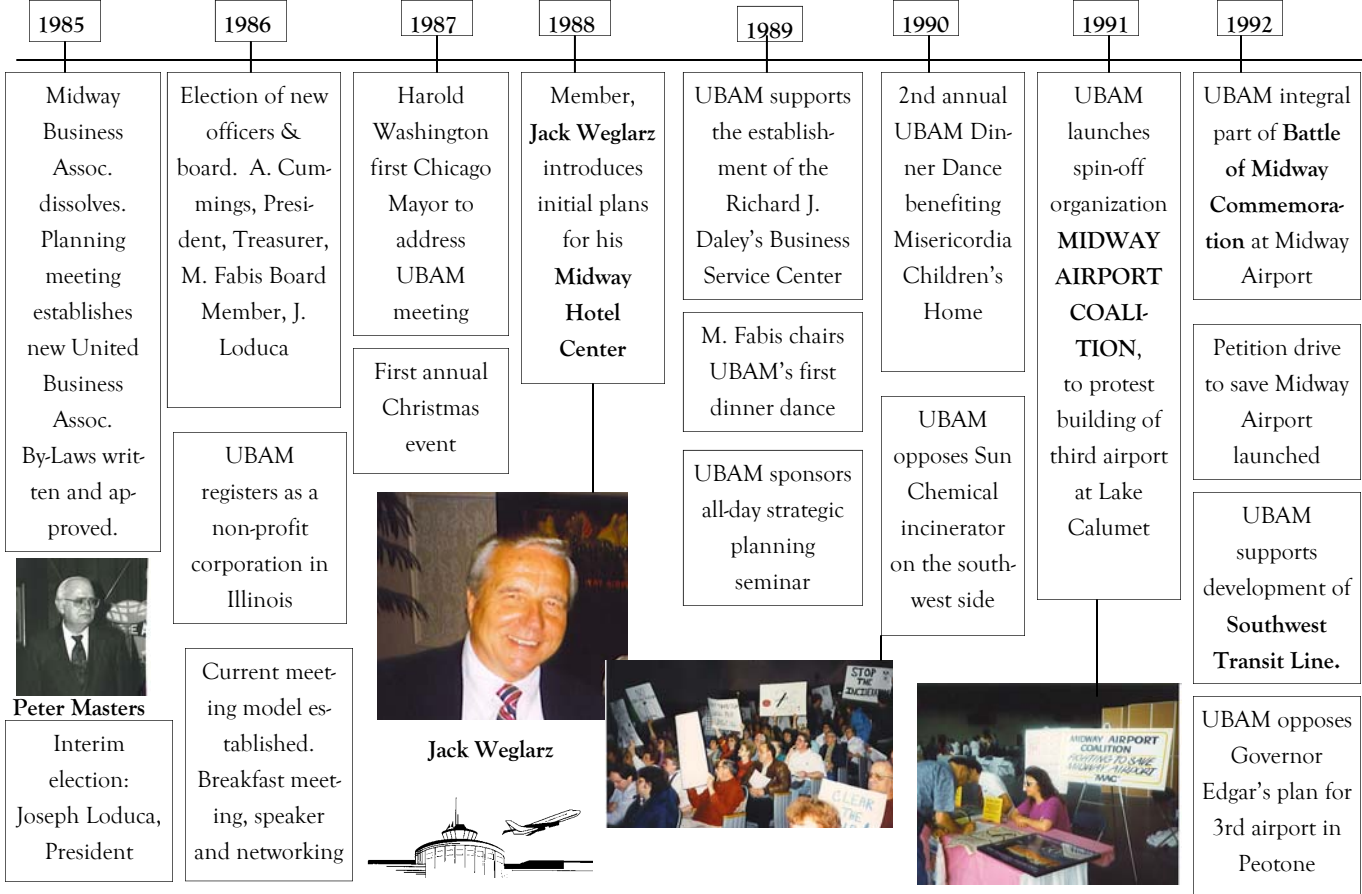
